7. <u>DISCUSSION ITEMS</u>

7.1 <u>Technology Update Presentation</u> – Mark Metzner, DRG/ICC

Item 7.1 was presented after the public comments section: At the request of the Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee, Mr. Mark Metzner presented an update of the District's technology projects. Mr. Metzner provided an Information Technology Project List which included the project title, the project description and the project completionmonth/year. Handouts included: ERUSD IT Project List, Service Infrastructure photos (before and after) and project timeline.

7.2 <u>Report on Activities</u>– E. Mejia

The visit to Rio Hondo College was a great visit; very impressed with their facilities along with their presentation. Ms. Mejia would like to see HPLE do more to publicize their meetings and suggested including a link on the District's website promoting the facilities master plan "for more information." Ms. Mejia is pleased with the work HPLE is doing and is looking forward to viewing one of their facilities in San Marcos next week.

7.3 <u>Bond Expenditures Update</u> – L. Covarrubias

Ms. Covarrubias provided two handouts, (1) Bond Fund 21, Trial Balance – Financial Report, as of April 30, 2014. Measure A: beginning balance \$12,556,042, net balance \$11,797,247. Measure EE: beginning balance \$782,454, net balance \$2,733,494.

(2) Bond Fund 21.0 Expenditure Summary for March 2014. The summary document now includes a project column and more details under the invoice description. Total expenditures for Measure A were \$15,809.99 and total expenditures for Measure EE were \$492.32. Ms. Covarrubias suggested creating a web-based drop box where detailed back up information can be reviewed in lieu of providing photocopies.

The committee was provided a chart of accounts as previously requested by Mr. Pacheco. Sample spreadsheets used by Rio Hondo College for tracking project expenses were also provided to the committee. Ms. Mejia asked if Ms. Covarrubias would provide information to the committee regarding Priority 1 and Priority II E-Rate funding.
