7. <u>DISCUSSION ITEMS</u>

7.1 **<u>Report on Activities</u>** – E. Mejia

On June 24, 2016 Ms. Mejia attended the special board meeting; items of interest included a presentation of the parcel tax/bond survey and a presentation of the bond possibility.

On August 2, 2016 Ms. Mejia attended the regular board meeting; items of interest included the resolution ordering an election on 11/8/2016 and authorizing the issuance of school bonds and the resolution calling for an election on 11/8/2016 for a school parcel tax; both items were pulled.

On August 5, 2016 Ms. Mejia attended the special board meeting; items of interest included the resolution ordering an election on 11/8/2016 and authorizing the issuance of school bonds and the resolution calling for an election on 11/8/2016 for a school parcel tax; both items were approved by the Board.

On August 23, 2016 Ms. Mejia, Ms. Castillo and Ms. Rodarte attended the Magee Academy of the Arts and Sciences Innovation Lab groundbreaking ceremony.

On August 25, 2016 Ms. Mejia attended the Valencia Academy of the Arts ribbon cutting.

Ms. Rodarte attended the Birney Tech Academy Innovation Lab groundbreaking ceremony.

Items of interest from the September 6, 2016 board meeting included:

Item 15.E.7 – A resolution to refund Measure A and EE bonds. Mr. Galindo explained that refunding was similar to refinancing and the goal is to reduce the interest rates/fees which could save approximately 2 million for the community over the life of the bonds.

Item 15.E.9 – Restated and amended CBOC bylaws were approved.

Item 15.E.11 – Measure A and EE audit report was approved; Nigro & Nigro provided an audit presentation to the Board.

Item 15.E.5 – Change order and final payment/ERHS gymnasium painting project; project was approved as a bond project by the Board of Education in May 2016. Mr. Galindo added that this project was funded with the savings (from the HVAC project) noted on the facilities funding plan. The El Rancho HS painting project (Buildings A, B, C & Library) was funded with the remaining bond fund savings along with developer fees.

7.2 **Bond Expenditures Update** – *M. Roychowdhury*

Trial Balance (2015-2016 Unaudited Actuals-Bond Fund 21): a combined balance for Measure A and Measure EE is \$12,494,377.23. Questions included: what is the settlement listed on the Bond Fund object list and is it possible to include the object codes on the expenditure reports?

Bond Measure A expenditures for April 2016 totaled \$100,986.28; Bond Measure EE expenditures for April 2016 totaled \$25,184.06.

Bond Measure A expenditures for May 2016 totaled \$119,960.81; Bond Measure EE expenditures for May 2016 totaled \$24,987.22.

Bond Measure A expenditures for June 2016 totaled \$169,044.27; Bond Measure EE expenditures for June 2016 totaled \$42,378.74.

- 7.3 Bond Projects Update (FMP-Board Approved Projects) C. Jimenez/J. Ortiz Mr. Ortiz provided a power point presentation "Measure A and Measure EE Progress Update" which included the Valencia Academy of the Arts Traffic Mitigation Project, the North Park Academy of the Arts Music Building and the Innovation and Science Labs project. Handouts included a copy of the presentation, HPLE rating system w/performance levels and rating system worksheet.
- 7.4 **<u>2013-14 Critical Questions/Recommendations</u>** Status of responses from ERUSD *E. Mejia* Critical questions/recommendations have not been answered from the cancelled joint meeting in June 2016. Ms. Mejia will forward the list to Mr. Galindo for review and research.

7.5 <u>2015-16 Audit Timeline Update</u>– M. Roychowdhury

Ms. Mejia asked if the bond audit would meet the timeline for the committee to complete the 2015-16 annual report before the committee terms out in February. Mr. Roychowdhury will speak to the auditor (Jeff Nigro) regarding expediting the bond audit. November and December are busy months for the auditors since the financial audits must be completed by December 15th and submitted to the county office. The financial audit should be ready to present to the Board of Education by January.
